HEARING VOICES SUPPORT GROUP – 6 APRIL 2017

Healthwatch Somerset visited the Hearing Voices support group in Taunton to introduce Healthwatch Somerset and to listen to any issues or concerns the group wanted to discuss.

INTRODUCTION

The hearing voices group has been running now for several years, and has just received funding from the Somerset Partnership to run for a further year. There were only two people attending at the time of visiting, but we were told there are sometimes six or more people at the group.

You said

Finding Work

It is difficult to get work, or even volunteering opportunities. People discriminate against me because of my disability.

I don't know where to find help to get work.

I would like to volunteer for somewhere like the National Trust, but have problems filling in forms.

It is soul destroying filling out application forms year after year and never hearing back.

Those who come to the group walk as transport and parking are expensive.

It can be difficult for a new person to come to the group for the first time. They need support to come.

There is a need for a befriender service.

The themes analysed from the feedback focusing on services, were:

- i. Not knowing where to find help to get a job
- ii. Needing support to access support

Conclusions

Those we spoke to said they felt isolated because of their disability and felt many people felt discriminated against. This made it difficult to find work opportunities, or to know where to turn for help.
