1	The Enter & View team recommend that the home consult with Action on Hearing Loss and take advice on the installation of hearing loop systems. Tel. 03332405659	Contacted the property team who are looking into this, catalogue has been requested from Action on Hearing loss.
2	The following good practice examples relating to resident and family meetings are shared here in the interests of sharing good practice picked from other EV visits. It is recommended the home • Making the meeting part of a larger event such as cheese and wine evening. • Ensuring that residents have the opportunity to add to the agenda and that they received the agenda well in advance. • Inviting guest speakers to talk about a topic of interest such as care home fees, hobbies, crafts, reminiscence or perhaps even a comedian. This would help to ensure that residents who may not otherwise attend might be motivated to give their input for different reasons. • Involve domestic, kitchen and activities staff	A cheese and wine evening has been organised on 8/7/15. The activities coordinator will take the agenda around before the meeting and will ask if there are any matters arising. Have contacted a local entertainer who is also a local historian who will be visiting the home.
